The personal impact (financially and in other ways) so far

With the pandemic and subsequent lockdowns it's been a struggle getting work at times, using up my savings and part of tax free sum of my pension to survive. Now I need to build up my reserves again, but given the amount I owe HMRC I'll never get back on my feet again, and my life will be curtailed as a result. This has all caused me incredible stress, anxiety and worry. I've been judged unfavourably by members of my own family

The personal impact (financially and in other ways) if HMRC enforce the Loan Charge as laid down in the legislation

My ability to save, and have financial security, to save for my future and retirement is seriously compromised, and I will have to say no to so much in the future, in fact for the rest of my life. The quality of my future as it stands at the moment is going to be seriously compromised and curtailed. I've worked hard all my life, paid my taxes, never claimed benefits. On this one occasion I took advice from my accountants who told me the scheme was HMRC compliant. I'm being severely punished while they walk away scot-free, with no accountability, and with the blessing of the Treasury.

I've had lots of sleepless nights, stress, anxiety and worry as a result, with no help from the accountants who got me in to this mess. They simply said to me they couldn't help. So any help and advice I've had I've had to find it myself.
